- 1. If you plan on ordering any regulated products (for example, chemicals), please provide identification that includes your business name and shipping address. Acceptable forms of identification include:
 - State issued document with Customer's Federal Tax ID Number
 - State issued document with Customer's Resale Tax ID Number
 - City or County issued Business License
 - State Department of Health Services License
 - DEA Registration Number
 - Bureau of Narcotics Precursor Business Permit
 - Any other ID issued by the state that includes the business name and address

Please Note for California: State regulatory guidelines stipulate that two (2) forms of identification are required to remove restrictions for chemicals. Please provide any two (2) of the items referenced above. In addition to the items referenced above, California allows one of the two forms of identification provided may be a personal drivers license by an employee of the company.

- 2. If you plan on ordering any licensed items (for example, needles, syringes, pharmaceuticals, alcohols, radio-actives or water for irrigation), please provide one of the following:
 - Doctor's License
 - Veterinary License
 - Pharmaceutical License
 - Pharmaceutical Distributors License

OR

- Certificate of Non Human / Non Animal Use which states the licensed item ordered will not be used on humans or animals. This form is provided herein.
